Our mission is to train, disciple and inspire followers of Christ, revealing Him to the world

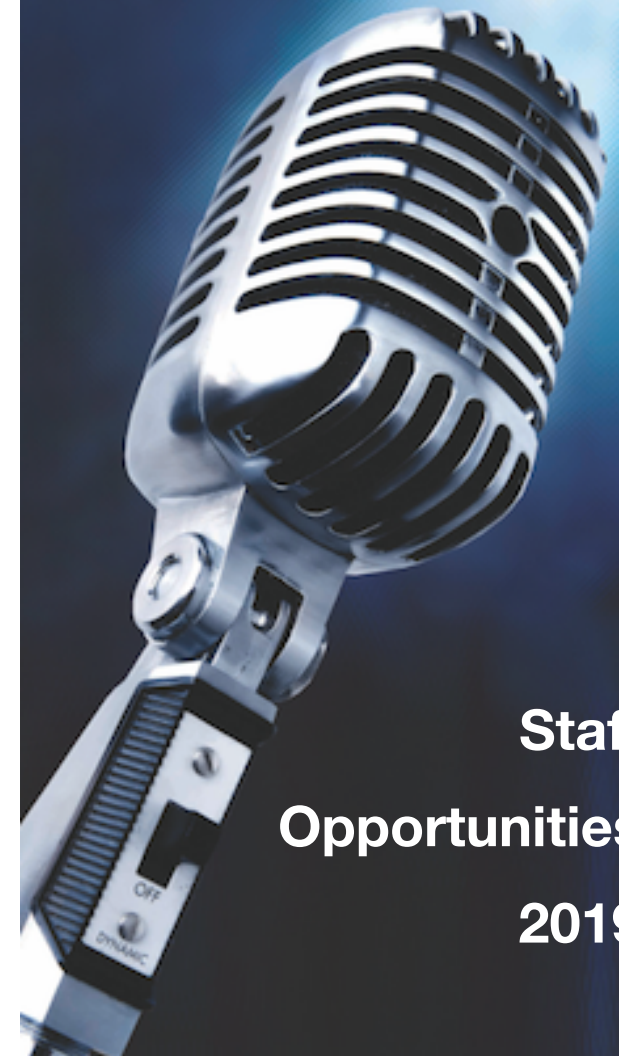
